



**Science**

- With an adult, visit a river or waterway; how many different types of rocks can you see? Draw a poster to show them.
- Design a floating vessel that could be used in a river.
- Create a booklet about the different animals that could be found in and around a river.

**Maths**

- With an adult, take a stopwatch or clock down to the river and see how long it takes for different types of sticks to travel between two fixed points along the river, draw a graph to show this.
- Keep working hard on your times tables, think of some of your own multiplication and division questions that you could answer.
- Have a play in the garden with lots of different measuring instruments (jugs, bottles, cups etc), can you find out how much liquid each one holds (in millilitres or litres)? Draw a table to show your findings

**Reading and writing**

- Write a poem or song about water, it could be about the journey of a river, the water cycle, or anything else water related.
- Create a non-fiction information page or powerpoint presentation all about rivers, have a look in some information books for ideas, there are some in the classroom.
