2. Aim

The aim of the Home School Agreement is to set out the spirit of the partnership which we will develop between Altarnun Primary parents and pupils.

During the time young people are at Altarnun Primary we believe that it is very important that a spirit of trust and co-operation is built up between staff, parents and pupils. This agreement sets out some of the specific ways, roles and responsibilities which will contribute to achieving this positive atmosphere. It is not a contract but expresses the willingness of all concerned to work together for the benefit of all young people in the academy. The Home School Agreement is in three sections, detailing the rights and responsibilities of the academy, the pupils, and the parents:

The aims of Altarnun Primary are:

- to provide pupils with a stimulating learning environment which prepares them for employment or for higher education
- to provide all pupils with equal opportunity to achieve academic, social and personal development through a diverse enrichment programme and personalised learning pathways

Home School Agreement

At Altarnun Primary:

- We will treat pupils fairly and encourage children to develop positive relationships
- We will encourage children to follow the golden rules and provide a safe, secure and stimulating learning environment
- We will provide a broad balanced and exciting curriculum suited to preparing each pupil to pursue the pathway tailored to their needs and abilities
- We will keep you regularly informed of your child's progress
- We will provide interesting and exciting extra-curricular activities and inform you of events that the academy is involved in
- We will let you know of any concerns that we have
- Tell your child what she/he needs for lessons.

As an Altarnun Primary Pupil:

- I will show honesty and respect to other children and adults
- I will follow the Academy Values and look after academy property
- I will always work hard and try my best. I will take responsibility for my own learning; including my homework
- I will work hard to achieve my targets, wear my uniform and bring to academy everything that I need for the day
